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Materials

- 1 skein of worsted weight yarn (approx. 150 yards)
- 5.0mm crochet hook
- Yarn needle
- Scissors

Gauge

4 stitches per inch

Finished Size

- 0-6 months: 14" circumference
- 6-12 months: 16" circumference
- 12-18 months: 18" circumference

Instructions

- 1. Chain 5 and join with a slip stitch to form a ring.
- 2. Round 1: Ch 1 (does not count as a stitch),12 sc into the ring. Join with a slip stitch to the first sc. (12 sc)
- 3. Round 2: Ch 1, 2 sc in each sc around. Join with a slip stitch to the first sc. (24 sc)
- 4. Round 3: Ch 1, *sc in the next 2 sc, 2 sc in the next sc*; repeat from * around. Join with a slip stitch to the first sc. (36 sc)
- 5. Round 4: Ch 1, *sc in the next 3 sc, 2 sc in the next sc*; repeat from * around. Join with a slip stitch to the first sc. (48 sc)
- 6. Round 5: Ch 1, *sc in the next 4 sc, 2 sc in the next sc*; repeat from * around. Join with a slip stitch to the first sc. (60 sc)
- Round 6: Ch 1, *sc in the next 5 sc, 2 sc in the next sc*; repeat from * around. Join with a slip stitch to the first sc. (72 sc)
- 8. Round 7: Ch 1, *sc in the next 6 sc, 2 sc in the next sc*; repeat from * around. Join with a slip stitch to the first sc. (84 sc)

- Round 8: Ch 1, *sc in the next 7 sc, 2 sc in the next sc*; repeat from * around. Join with a slip stitch to the first sc. (96 sc)
- 10. Round 9: Ch 1, *sc in the next 8 sc, 2 sc in the next sc*; repeat from * around. Join with a slip stitch to the first sc. (108 sc)
- 11. Round 10: Ch 1, *sc in the next 9 sc, 2 sc in the next sc*; repeat from * around. Join with a slip stitch to the first sc. (120 sc)
- 12. Round 11: Ch 1, sc around. Join with a slip stitch to the first sc. (120 sc)
- 13. Round 12: Ch 1, *sc in the next 2 sc, 2 sc in the next sc*; repeat from * around. Join with a slip stitch to the first sc. (132 sc)
- 14. Round 13: Ch 1, *sc in the next 3 sc, 2 sc in the next sc*; repeat from * around. Join with a slip stitch to the first sc. (144 sc)
- 15. Round 14: Ch 1, *sc in the next 4 sc, 2 sc in the next sc*; repeat from * around. Join with a slip stitch to the first sc. (156 sc)
- 16. Round 15: Ch 1, *sc in the next 5 sc, 2 sc in the next sc*; repeat from * around. Join with a slip stitch to the first sc. (168 sc)
- 17. Round 16: Ch 1, *sc in the next 6 sc, 2 sc in the next sc*; repeat from * around. Join with a slip stitch to the first sc. (180 sc)
- 18. Round 17: Ch 1, *sc in the next 7 sc, 2 sc in the next sc*; repeat from * around. Join with a slip stitch to the first sc. (192 sc)
- 19. Round 18: Ch 1, *sc in the next 8 sc, 2 sc in the next sc*; repeat from * around. Join with a slip stitch to the first sc. (204 sc)
- 20. Round 19: Ch 1, *sc in the next 9 sc, 2 sc in the next sc*; repeat from * around. Join with a slip stitch to the first sc. (216 sc)

- 21. Round 20: Ch 1, sc in each sc around. Join with a slip stitch to the first sc. (216 sc)
- 22. Fasten off and weave in loose ends.

Customization

This baby turban hat crochet pattern is very versatile and can be customized to suit your own taste. Here are a few ideas:

- Use different colors of yarn to create a unique look.
- Add embellishments such as pom-poms, tassels, or flowers.
- Make the hat longer or shorter by adding or removing rows.
- Adjust the size of the hat by using a different size crochet hook.

Tips

- Be sure to check your gauge before starting to crochet the hat. This will ensure that the hat fits properly.
- If you are a beginner, I recommend using a stitch marker to keep track of the beginning of each round.

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
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
