Pattern Instructions

Body

- With brown yarn, make a magic circle.
- Round 1: Sc 6 into the circle, sl st to join. (6 sc)
- Round 2: 2 sc in each sc around, sl st to join. (12 sc)
- Round 3: (Sc in next sc, hdc in next sc) around, sl st to join. (18 sc, 6 hdc)
- Round 4-6: Sc in each st around, sl st to join. (18 sc)

Head

- Round 7: (Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc) around, sl st to join. (24 sc)

- Round 8: (Sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc) around, sl st to join. (30 sc)
- Round 9: (Sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc) around, sl st to join. (36 sc)
- Round 10: (Sc in next 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc) around, sl st to join. (42 sc)
- Round 11-12: Sc in each st around, sl st to join. (42 sc)

Wings (make 2)

- With brown yarn, make a magic circle.
- Round 1: Sc 6 into the circle, sl st to join. (6 sc)
- Round 2: 2 sc in each sc around, sl st to join. (12 sc)
- Round 3: (Sc in next sc, hdc in next sc) around, sl st to join. (18 sc, 6 hdc)
- Round 4-5: Sc in each st around, sl st to join. (18 sc)
- Round 6: (Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc) around, sl st to join. (24 sc)
- Round 7: (Sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc) around, sl st to join. (30 sc)
- Round 8: Sc in each st around, sl st to join. (30 sc)
- Fasten off and weave in the ends.

Eyes

- With white yarn, make 2 magic circles.
- Round 1: Sc 6 into the circle, sl st to join. (6 sc)
- Round 2: (Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc) around, sl st to join. (9 sc)
- Round 3: Sc in each st around, sl st to join. (9 sc)

- Fasten off and weave in the ends.

Beak

- With yellow yarn, make a magic circle.
- Round 1: Sc 6 into the circle, sl st to join. (6 sc)
- Round 2: (Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc) around, sl st to join. (9 sc)
- Round 3: Sc in each st around, sl st to join. (9 sc)
- Fasten off and weave in the ends.

Crocodile Stitch (for belly)

- Row 1: With brown yarn, sc 10.
- Row 2: Sc in next sc, 2 dc in next sc, sc next 2 sc. Repeat. (10 cdc)
- Row 3: Ch 1, sc in 2nd cdc, *(2 dc in next cdc, sc in next cdc)*. Repeat from * to *. (10 cdc)
- Repeat Row 3 until crocodile stitch area is wide enough to cover the owl's belly.
- Fasten off and weave in the ends.

Assembly

- Sew the wings onto the sides of the body.
- Sew the eyes onto the head.
- Sew the beak onto the head.

- Sew the head onto the body.
- Sew the crocodile stitch panel onto the bottom of the owl's belly, covering the seam where the head and body meet.
- Your Crocodile Stitch Owl Applique is complete!

Tips and Tricks

- Use a stitch marker to keep track of the first stitch in each round.
- Tighten the tension of your crocodile stitch to create a dense and textured effect.
- Add beads or sequins to the owl's eyes for a touch of sparkle.

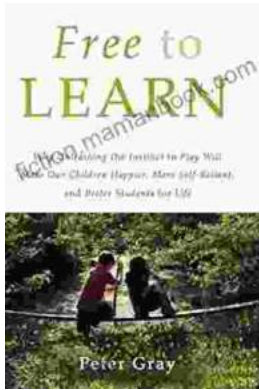

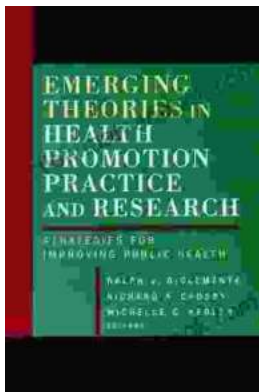
