Step 1: Cast On

Using the US size 6 (4mm) knitting needles, cast on 60 stitches.

Step 2: Knit in the Rib Pattern

Row 1: *K1, P1; repeat from * to the end of the row.

Row 2: *K1, P1; repeat from * to the end of the row.

Repeat Rows 1 and 2 until the hat measures 4 inches from the cast-on edge.

Step 3: Decrease for the Crown

Row 1: *K2tog, K1, P1; repeat from * to the end of the row.

Row 2: *K1, P1; repeat from * to the end of the row.

Repeat Rows 1 and 2, decreasing by one stitch in each row, until there are 12 stitches remaining on the needle.

Step 4: Close the Crown

Thread the yarn needle with the remaining yarn. Pull the yarn through the remaining stitches and pull tight to close the crown of the hat.

Step 5: Weave in Ends

Use the yarn needle to weave in any loose ends of yarn.

Congratulations!

You have now successfully completed this adorable ribbed hat for your premature to newborn baby. Whether you choose to keep it for your own little one or gift it to a special someone, this cozy creation is sure to be cherished for years to come.

Additional Tips:

- For a premature baby, you may want to adjust the size of the hat by casting on fewer stitches or using a smaller needle size.

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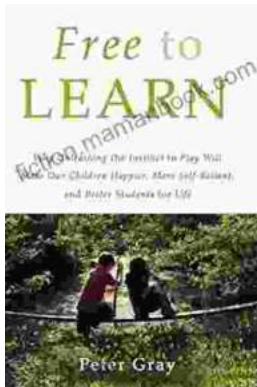
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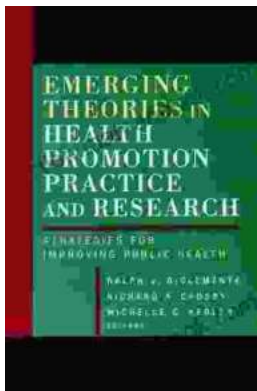
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
