Materials You'll Need:

- Worsted weight yarn (brown, red, black, and white)
- 4.00mm (G/6) crochet hook
- Polyester fiberfill
- Yarn needle
- Scissors

- Stitch marker (optional)

Skill Level:

This pattern is suitable for beginners who are comfortable with basic crochet stitches. Detailed instructions and photo illustrations will guide you through each step of the process.

Finished Size:

Approximately 6 inches (15 cm) tall

Instructions:

Body:

1. With brown yarn, make a magic ring.
2. Round 1: 6sc in ring (6)
3. Round 2: 2sc in each sc (12)
4. Round 3: *sc in next sc, 2sc in next sc* (18)
5. Round 4-7: sc in each sc (18)
6. Round 8: *sc in next 4 sc, dec (2sc tog)* (15)
7. Round 9: *sc in next 3 sc, dec* (12)
8. Round 10: *sc in next 2 sc, dec* (9)
9. Round 11: dec in each sc (6)
10. Stuff the body with fiberfill.
11. Close the hole by sewing the remaining stitches together.

Head:

1. With brown yarn, make a magic ring.
2. Round 1: 6sc in ring (6)
3. Round 2: 2sc in each sc (12)
4. Round 3-4: sc in each sc (12)
5. Stuff the head with fiberfill.
6. Close the hole by sewing the remaining stitches together.

Antlers:

1. With brown yarn, make a magic ring.
2. Round 1: 3sc in ring (3)
3. Round 2: 2sc in each sc (6)
4. Round 3: *sc in next sc, 2sc in next sc* (9)
5. Round 4-6: sc in each sc (9)
6. Fold the antler in half and sew the edges together to form a triangle.
7. Repeat steps to make the second antler.

Nose:

1. With red yarn, make a magic ring.
2. Round 1: 6sc in ring (6)
3. Round 2: *sc in next 2 sc, inc (2sc in next sc)* (9)
4. Close the hole by sewing the remaining stitches together.

5. Stuff the nose with fiberfill.
6. Sew the nose onto the face.

Eyes:

1. With black yarn, make 2 magic rings.
2. Round 1: 6sc in ring (6)
3. Close the hole by sewing the remaining stitches together.
4. Sew the eyes onto the face.

Mouth:

1. With black yarn, embroider a small line for the mouth.

Scarf:

1. With red yarn, chain 30.
2. Hdc in each chain stitch (30).
3. Fasten off and weave in ends.
4. Wrap the scarf around the reindeer's neck and sew it in place.

Assembly:

1. Sew the head onto the body.
2. Sew the antlers onto the head.

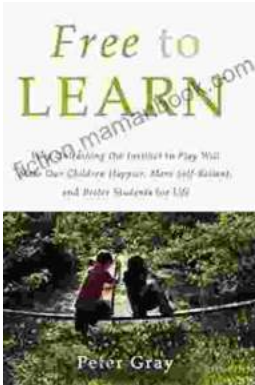

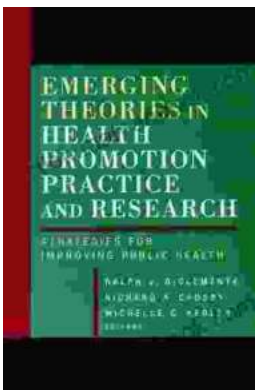
