

- Worsted weight yarn (approx. 200 yards)
- Size H (5 mm) crochet hook
- Yarn needle
- Scissors

Instructions

- 1. **Row 1:** Ch 20, sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across. (19 sc) Turn.
- 2. Row 2: Ch 1, sc in each sc across. (19 sc) Turn.
- 3. Row 3: Ch 1, sc in first sc, 2 sc in next sc, *sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc*; repeat from * to * across. (28 sc) Turn.
- 4. Row 4: Ch 1, sc in each sc across. (28 sc) Turn.
- 5. Row 5: Ch 1, sc in first 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc, *sc in next 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc*; repeat from * to * across. (35 sc) Turn.
- 6. Row 6: Ch 1, sc in each sc across. (35 sc) Turn.
- 7. Row 7: Ch 1, sc in first 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc, *sc in next 5 sc, 2 sc in next sc*; repeat from * to * across. (42 sc) Turn.
- 8. Row 8: Ch 1, sc in each sc across. (42 sc) Turn.
- 9. Row 9: Ch 1, sc in first 5 sc, 2 sc in next sc, *sc in next 6 sc, 2 sc in next sc*; repeat from * to * across. (49 sc) Turn.
- 10. **Row 10:** Ch 1, sc in each sc across. (49 sc) Turn.
- 11. **Row 11:** Ch 1, sc in first 6 sc, 2 sc in next sc, *sc in next 7 sc, 2 sc in next sc*; repeat from * to * across. (56 sc) Turn.
- 12. Row 12: Ch 1, sc in each sc across. (56 sc) Turn.

- 13. Row 13: Ch 1, sc in first 7 sc, 2 sc in next sc, *sc in next 8 sc, 2 sc in next sc*; repeat from * to * across. (63 sc) Turn.
- 14. Row 14: Ch 1, sc in each sc across. (63 sc) Turn.
- 15. Row 15: Ch 1, sc in first 8 sc, 2 sc in next sc, *sc in next 9 sc, 2 sc in next sc*; repeat from * to * across. (70 sc) Turn.
- 16. Row 16: Ch 1, sc in each sc across. (70 sc) Turn.
- 17. Row 17: Ch 1, sc in first 9 sc, 2 sc in next sc, *sc in next 10 sc, 2 sc in next sc*; repeat from * to * across. (77 sc) Turn.
- 18. Row 18: Ch 1, sc in each sc across. (77 sc) Turn.
- 19. Row 19: Ch 1, sc in first 10 sc, 2 sc in next sc, *sc in next 11 sc, 2 sc in next sc*; repeat from * to * across. (84 sc) Turn.
- 20. Row 20: Ch 1, sc in each sc across. (84 sc) Turn.
- 21. Row 21: Ch 1, sc in first 11 sc, 2 sc in next sc, *sc in next 12 sc, 2 sc in next sc*; repeat from * to * across. (91 sc) Turn.
- 22. Row 22: Ch 1, sc in each sc across. (91 sc) Turn.
- 23. Row 23: Ch 1, sc in first 12 sc, 2 sc in next sc, *sc in next 13 sc, 2 sc in next sc*; repeat from * to * across. (98 sc) Turn.
- 24. **Row 24:** Ch 1, sc in each sc across. (98 sc) Turn.
- 25. Row 25: Ch 1, sc in first 13 sc, 2 sc in next sc, *sc in next 14 sc, 2 sc in next sc*; repeat from * to * across. (105 sc) Turn.
- 26. **Row 26:** Ch 1, sc in each sc across. (105 sc) Turn.
- 27. Row 27: Ch 1, sc in first 14 sc, 2 sc in next sc, *sc in next 15 sc, 2 sc in next sc*; repeat from * to * across. (112 sc) Turn.

28. Row 28: Ch 1, sc in each sc across. (112 sc) Turn.

Finishing

- 1. Fold the slipper in half, with the right sides together. Sew up the back seam, leaving a small opening for turning. Turn the slipper right side out.
- 2. Sew up the opening in the back seam.
- 3. Weave in any loose ends.

You've now finished your very own pair of crochet slippers. Enjoy wearing them around the house or give them as a gift to someone special.

Tips

- If you want to make your slippers a little more durable, you can use a thicker yarn or double up on the yarn.
- You can also add a non-slip sole to your slippers to help prevent them from sliding around on slippery surfaces.
- If you're not sure what size to make your slippers, you can measure your foot and refer to the chart below:

I Foot Length | Slipper Size | |---| 9 inches | Small | | 10 inches | Medium | | 11 inches | Large | | 12 inches | X-Large |

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






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
