Materials

- Yarn: Worsted weight yarn in your desired color (approximately 250-300 yards)
- Needles: US size 8 (5mm) knitting needles
- Stitch markers
- Tapestry needle

Gauge

18 stitches and 24 rows = 4 inches in stockinette stitch

Sizes

Baby: 6-12 months

■ Toddler: 12-24 months

Pattern

Body

Cast on 60 (66) stitches.

Row 1: Knit

Row 2: Purl

Rows 3-4: Repeat Rows 1-2.

Rows 5-8: Stockinette stitch (knit every row).

Row 9: Purl

Rows 10-12: Repeat Rows 1-2.

Rows 13-14: Stockinette stitch

Rows 15-16: Repeat Rows 1-2.

Rows 17-18: Stockinette stitch

Repeat Rows 1-18 until the piece measures approximately 10 (11) inches from the cast-on edge.

Tulip Flowers

Row 1: *Knit 6, place a stitch marker, knit 13, place a stitch marker, knit

until the end of the row.*

Row 2: Purl

Row 3: *Knit 6, slip the next 13 stitches onto a holder, knit until the end of

the row.*

Row 4: Purl

Rows 5-8: Repeat Rows 1-4 three more times.

Row 9: *Knit 6, cast on 13 new stitches, knit until the end of the row.*

Rows 10-12: Repeat Rows 1-2.

Row 13: *Knit 6, slip the next 13 stitches onto the left-hand needle, knit 13

from the holder, knit until the end of the row.*

Row 14: Purl

Rows 15-16: Repeat Rows 1-2.

Row 17: Knit

Cut the yarn and pull it through the remaining stitches to bind off.

Repeat Steps 1-6 to create the remaining tulip flowers.

Straps

Cast on 16 (18) stitches.

Knit every row until the strap measures approximately 14 (16) inches.

Cut the yarn and pull it through the remaining stitches to bind off.

Repeat to create a second strap.

Assembly

Sew the tulip flowers onto the body of the dress, spacing them evenly apart.

Sew the straps to the top of the dress, approximately 2 inches from the side seams.

Weave in any loose ends.


Tips

- To change the size of the dress, simply adjust the number of stitches cast on.
- You can use any type of worsted weight yarn for this pattern.
- If you don't have a stitch marker, you can use a safety pin or a piece of scrap yarn to mark the stitches.
- Be sure to check the gauge of your knitting before you start to ensure that the dress will fit properly.

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






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
