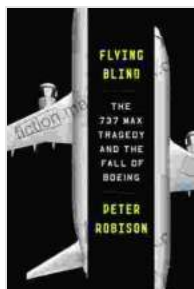


The 737 Max Tragedy and the Fall of Boeing

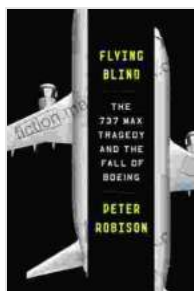

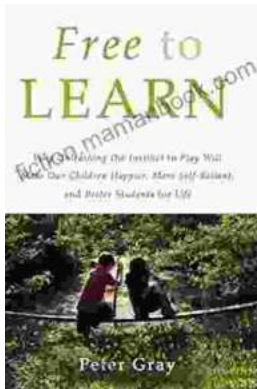

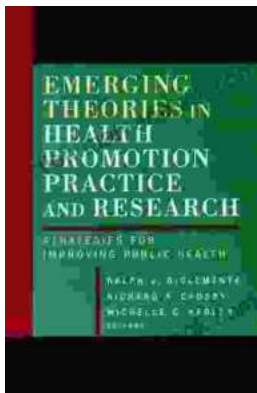
