Questions About Your Skills and Experience

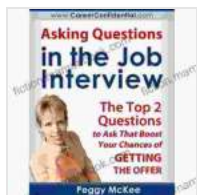
- **How do my skills and experience match the requirements of the role?** This question gives you the opportunity to highlight your skills and experience and to explain how they would benefit the company.

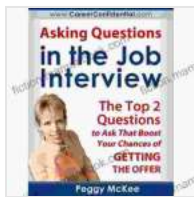
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- **Be prepared.** Take the time to research the company and the role, and come up with a list of questions that you want to ask.

By asking the right questions, you can make a great impression on the interviewer and increase your chances of getting

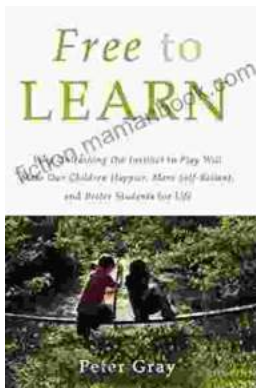


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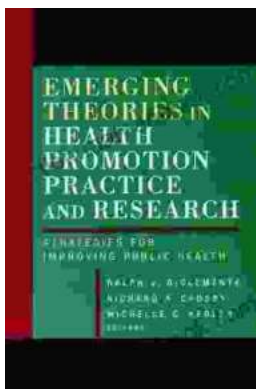
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
